Virtual

- Power School landing page for daily agenda
- SeeSaw for content including all special classes
- Do at your own pace (one day delay)
- Video recordings, voice responses, and message responses
- Weekly packets of materials sent home

- All special classes will be virtual
- Snack and lunch in the classroom or outside

School Supplies

Tote Bags and Rest Mats

- All **new** students will receive their tote bags before school starts (August 7th) with one lunch container.
- If you are a returning student and need a new tote bag, you can order one by reserving one.
- You may purchase your own rest mat cover or you can order one through us. We use Happi Nappi brand rest mats.
- You can reserve a rest mat cover or a tote bag on our website by clicking on Admissions, then Now That You've Been Accepted
- Please mail or drop off all payments to the address on the order form.





Lunch, Snacks, and Birthday Treats

- Lunch can be brought from home or ordered through our dining hall (hot or cold option).
- Each student will need to bring one snack if not attending EDA or two snacks if attending EDA. Please LABEL these snacks as such!
- Please send a refillable water bottle to school each day. Milk is provided with school lunches or can be purchased for lunches from home.
- No outside food is allowed on campus at this time. Birthday treats may be ordered from our dining hall.

Orientation Days and Extended Day Activities

- If you did not receive a letter in the mail with your child's class assignment or Orientation Day, please email cmaurizi@saa-sds.org
- Your child will only come one orientation day, for first half of the day. EDA is not available on Orientation Days.
- EDA will be held in each child's classroom.
- EDA is only available with the five day option to maintain staffing ratios. It is billed monthly from your FACTS account.
- EDA will close at 5:30 p.m. each day for our maintenance crew to have additional time to clean.



First Day of School

- Start talking excitedly about school now! Talk
 your child about what drop off will look like in positive terms.
- Create a routine now so the transition will be easier. Scale back wake up times slowly.
- Practice wearing a mask with your child. Start slow and add time each day. Wear a mask with them as an example.
- Gaiter masks are easier to wear (child size), you will need one per day and a back up mask in their tote bag.



Drop Off and Pick Up

- Temperatures will be checked daily at drop off. Please have your child ready to exit the car by pausing before you pull up to unbuckle your child, gather their things, roll down the window, and unlock your doors.
- PK and PK2 students will have the option to walk their child to the building because they have doors to the outside. JK will need to use the car pool lane to drop off.
- In order to keep our drop off lines moving, BE READY!
- When picking up your child, DO NOT EXIT your vehicle. Pull up to the end of the drive to buckle your child.
