The Leadership Scholarship

The Leadership Scholarship was established in 2002 to recognize deserving incoming ninth grade students who demonstrate excellent leadership skills.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Limited to a rising freshman who demonstrates excellent leadership in her school and community
- Student must evidence high academic standards and good citizenship
- Student must be enrolled for the 2019-20 school to be considered

How to Apply:

1. Complete the SAA General Scholarship Application included in this packet
2. Complete the Leadership Scholarship Application included in this packet and all requested attachments
3. Mail application to Barbara Olson by April 5th. **Late submissions will not be accepted.**

The Leadership Scholarship is a \$750 award that will be applied against tuition for the 2019-20 school year. Recipient's current school will be notified of her award so that she may be recognized at her school's awards assembly or graduation.

The Margaret McNulty Walsh Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Margie Walsh '44, music teacher and Glee Club Director at St. Agnes for 25 years, by her family.

- Limited to a rising freshman who demonstrates excellence in music
- Student must evidence good citizenship
- Student must be enrolled for the 2019-20 school year to be considered

How to Apply:

1. Complete the Walsh Scholarship Application included in this packet
2. Mail application to Barbara Olson by April 5th. **Late submissions will not be accepted.**
3. **Applicants should prepare a short piece to be presented and judged at an audition Tuesday, April 16th at 3:45 p.m at Siena Hall.** If singing, you must provide accompaniment or sing a cappella. (A piano will be available.)
