SAA seeks and enrolls students from Memphis, surrounding communities, and from areas of Mississippi and Arkansas. SAA students are admitted through a comprehensive application process as well as an in-house placement test.

The school actively encourages academic excellence and promotes spiritual and moral growth, social and ecological responsibility, leadership skills, multicultural awareness, emotional maturity, artistic expression, and physical fitness. Study, Prayer, Community, and Service - are woven into the daily lives of our students.

SAA Curriculum

St. Agnes offers 18 Advanced Placement (AP) courses, 30 Honors (H) courses, 3 Dual Enrollment language courses, and a Biomedical STEM track.

- 4 years of English
- 4 years of Math
- 3 years of Science (4 years is recommended)
- 3 years of Social Science
- 2 years of World Language
- 1 year of Fine Arts
- 1 semester of Health
- 1 semester of Leadership

Theology is required each year while at St. Agnes.

PE is required if the student has not participated in 2 consecutive years of a sport.

Community Service

- 100 service hours required for graduation
- 4,093 total service hours for the Class of 2024
- Senior year, students complete a *Path to Caritas* Capstone Project. This capstone project gives our students a chance to explore injustices in our society, connect with local non-profit organizations, and utilize their learning of the Circle of Social Action - to see, judge, and act.

Fine Arts

- SAA's fine arts program celebrates self expression and connects students to history, diverse culture, and their own imagination.
- *Calliope* - National award-winning literary magazine published entirely by SAA students. Student works in Calliope have won several Columbia Scholastic Gold Circle Awards.
- Theatre Arts - students are recognized and awarded for their performances by the Orpheum High School Musical Theatre (HSMT) Awards. In 2024, SAA earned 15 nominations and 6 awards. Recent productions include *Beehive*, *Leaving Iowa*, and *The Addams Family*.

Athletics

Exchange Program

SAA has a partnership with the Colegio La Salle in Costa Rica. SAA host families welcome La Salle students each January for 2 weeks. Selected SAA students travel to Costa Rica for 2 weeks to stay with host families and are immersed in Costa Rican culture and education.

St. Agnes Academy does not rank its students with the exception of the Valedictorian, Salutatorian, and Third Honors at graduation.

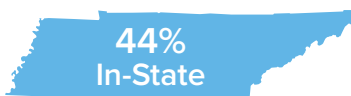
COVID-19

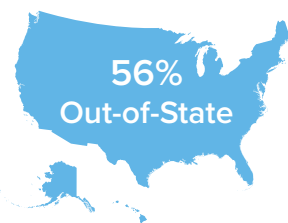
College Matriculation
